



RULE CONCERNING THE PAYMENT OF HONORARIA TO STUDENT REPRESENTATIVES

AUTHORITY

A Rule of the Adelaide University Union (AUU) enacted pursuant to clause 20 of the Constitution

POLICY

1. Objectives

- 1.1 To ensure the President of the AUU is adequately remunerated
- 1.2 To allow other elected student representatives within the organization, and its affiliates, to be adequately remunerated for their tasks

2. Definitions

- 2.1 The definitions in Clause 3 of the AUU Constitution apply to this policy.

3. Interpretation

Interpretation of this policy is within the jurisdiction of the President, pursuant to the authority of Board.

4. Classification

- 4.1 All honoraria paid to annually elected student representatives must be linked to the classification of Adelaide University Union Employees Award Level 1, and must be expressed as a proportion, at no greater than 100% of this classification and no less than 75%.
- 4.2 The Immediate Past President shall receive an honorarium of half that of the President in the two weeks immediately following their term. In return, the Immediate Past President shall conduct an induction and orientation for the new President.
- 4.3 The rate of this classification is not affected by any Collective Agreement entered into by the AUU
- 4.4 Honoraria shall, as far as practicable, be distributed in equal part payments fortnightly for the duration of the elected student representative's term. Lump sum payments of honoraria may only be approved by a Special Resolution of Board.
- 4.5 Honoraria for elected student representatives, including the President of the AUU, shall only be approved through the budgeting process.



5. Mobile Phone Subsidy

The President of the AUU will be provided with a mobile phone subsidy of \$70 a month.
