



# **RULES CONCERNING TERMS ON WHICH MEMBERSHIP IS OFFERED**

## **AUTHORITY**

A Rule of the Adelaide University Union (AUU) enacted  
pursuant to Clause 20 of the AUU Constitution

## **RULES**

### **1. Objectives**

The following determines the terms under which membership is offered

### **2. Definitions**

The definitions in Clause 3 of the AUU Constitution apply to this Rule.

### **3. Interpretation**

Interpretation of these Rules is within the jurisdiction of the President, pursuant to the authority of Board.

### **4. Students**

The AUU offers certain core services to all Students, regardless of whether they are an Ordinary Member or not.

All Students are entitled to vote in AUU Annual Elections and Referenda

### **5. Ordinary Members**

Ordinary Members are Students who choose to purchase financial membership of the AUU on terms determined by the Board from time to time.

Ordinary Members are entitled to stand in AUU Annual Elections, provided that they comply with Clause 7.1 of the Constitution.

### **6. Associate Members**

Associate Members are persons who are not Students who choose to purchase financial membership of the AUU on terms determined by the Board from time to time.

Associate members are not entitled to vote in AUU Annual Elections and Referenda.



## **7. Life Members**

Life Members are persons that are conferred membership under Clause 4.2.3 of the Constitution, provided that they consent to Life Membership.

Life Members are not entitled to vote in AUU Annual Elections and Referenda.
